The objective of the Education Committee has been to enhance student knowledge of waste management with emphasis on environmental protection.

I've been able to attend meetings of the Public Information Committee FRSWC. Brenda McCallum, Gloria Rowe and Richard McLean have been very generous with their time to share knowledge of their activities with me. Their skill, dedication and professionalism have been of significant value.

Four one thousand dollar Fundy Environmental Scholarships have been awarded. Emily Nelson and Peter Coates have received scholarships at UNBSJ. Sarah Campbell and Miles Richard were the recipients at NBCC. All four are residents of the host communities.

One thousand dollars was provided to FRSWC to help defray costs of transportation of host community students, particularly grade four, for an educational tour of the landfill site.

Host community funding of six hundred dollars per school has been provided. Grand Bay and Inglewood schools have already used this funding while River Valley, Westfield and Morna Heights are in the process.
