

Special Projects Report 2024

The Special Projects Committee is responsible for awarding funding for community projects that have a positive environmental and/or social impact in the Host Community. Applications are evaluated based on their positive impact, viability, and degree of impact. The amount allocated to the Special Projects fund is based on approximately \$1.00 per ton of waste collected during the year at the Crane Mountain Landfill.

In 2023, \$96,211 in funds were paid in full to successful fund applicants as follows:
